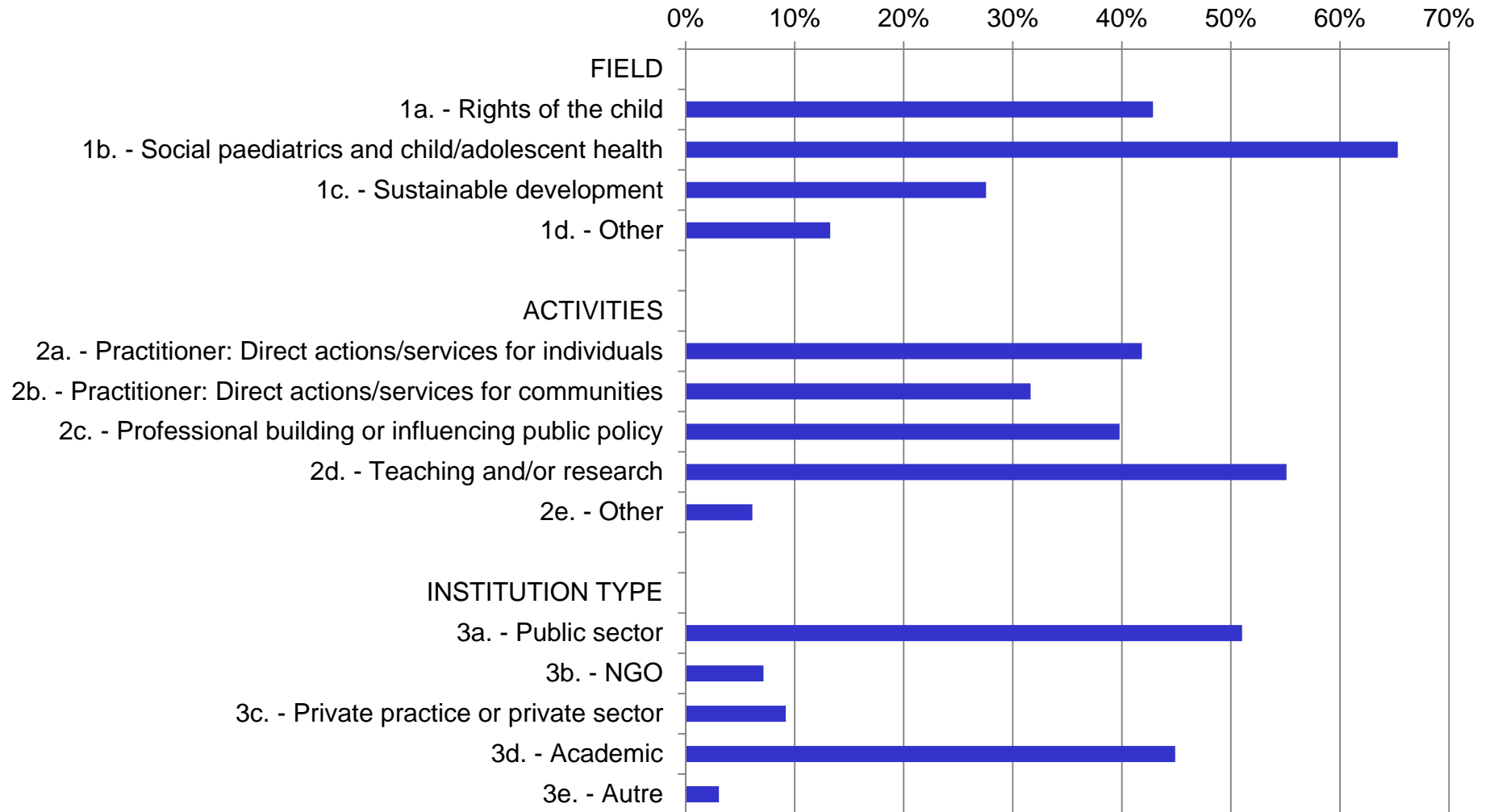

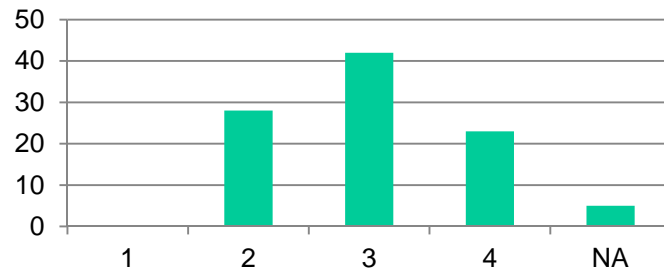

Participants characteristics (N=98)

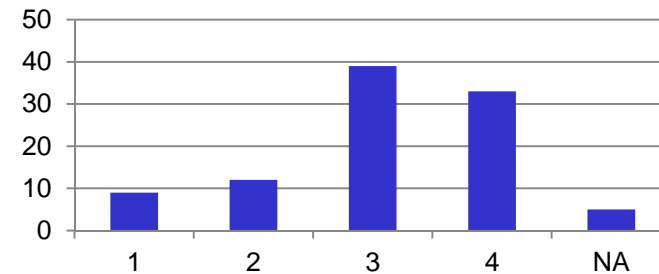


Knowledge level - BEFORE

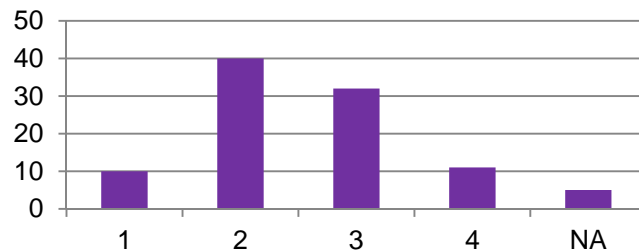
child rights (N=98)

Social pediatrics

- A **global, holistic, and multidisciplinary** approach to child health;
- it considers the health of the child within the **context of their society, environment, school, and family**,
- **integrating** the physical, mental, and social dimensions of child health and development as well as care, prevention, and promotion of health and quality of life.
- Focus on:
 - child health problems with social causes,
 - child health problems with social consequences, and
 - child health care in society

Community pediatrics

- A perspective that expands the pediatrician's focus from **one child to** the well-being of **all children in the community**;
- A recognition that **family, educational, social, cultural, spiritual, economic, environmental, and political forces** affect the health and functioning of children;
- A **synthesis of clinical practice and public health principles** to promote the health of all children **within the context of the family, school, and community**⁵; and
- A **commitment to collaborate with community partners to advocate** for and provide **quality services equitably** for all children.^{6,7}

Why should professionals go to this meeting?

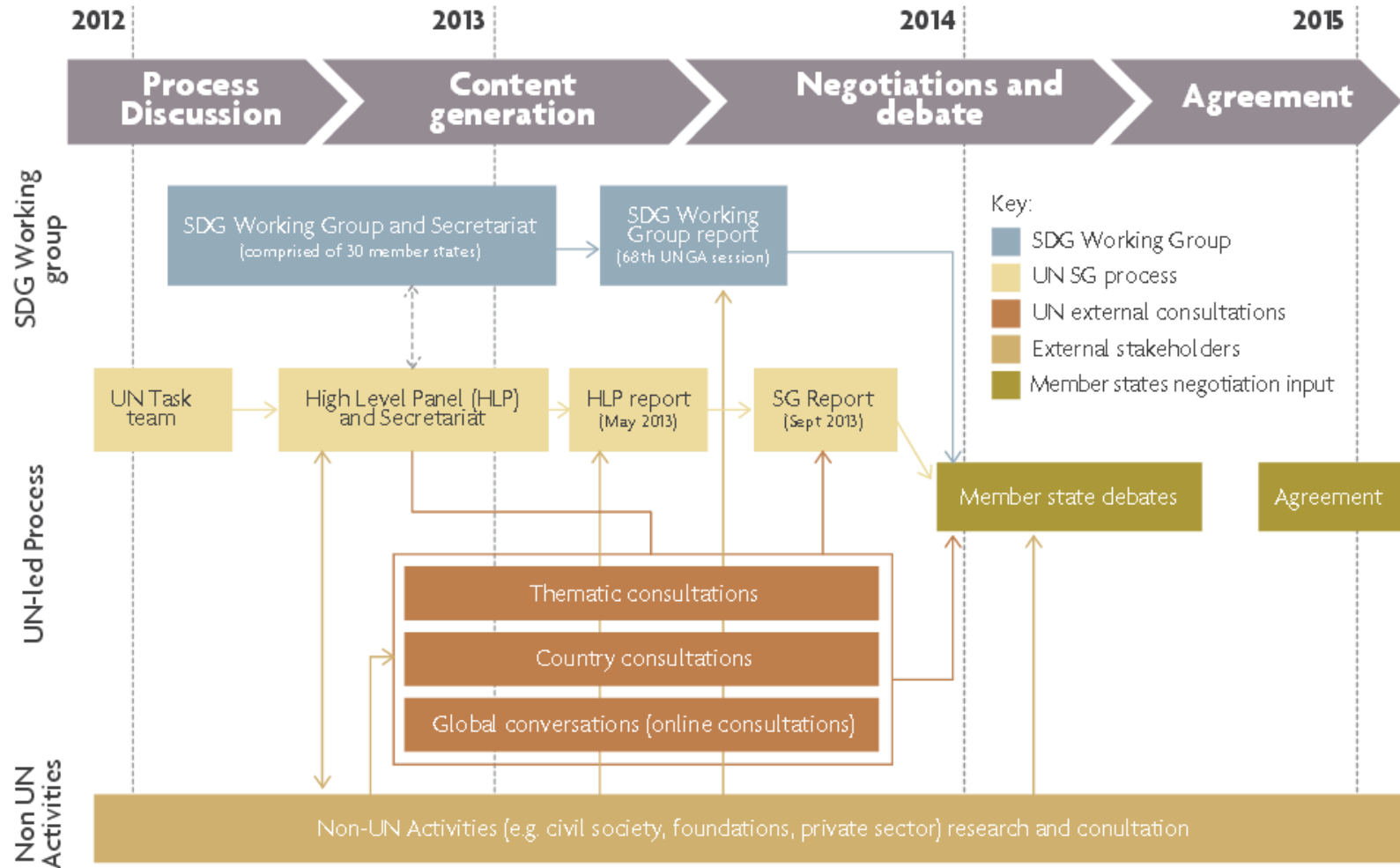
- To understand better what are the new Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) that will replace the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) from 1st Jan 2016.

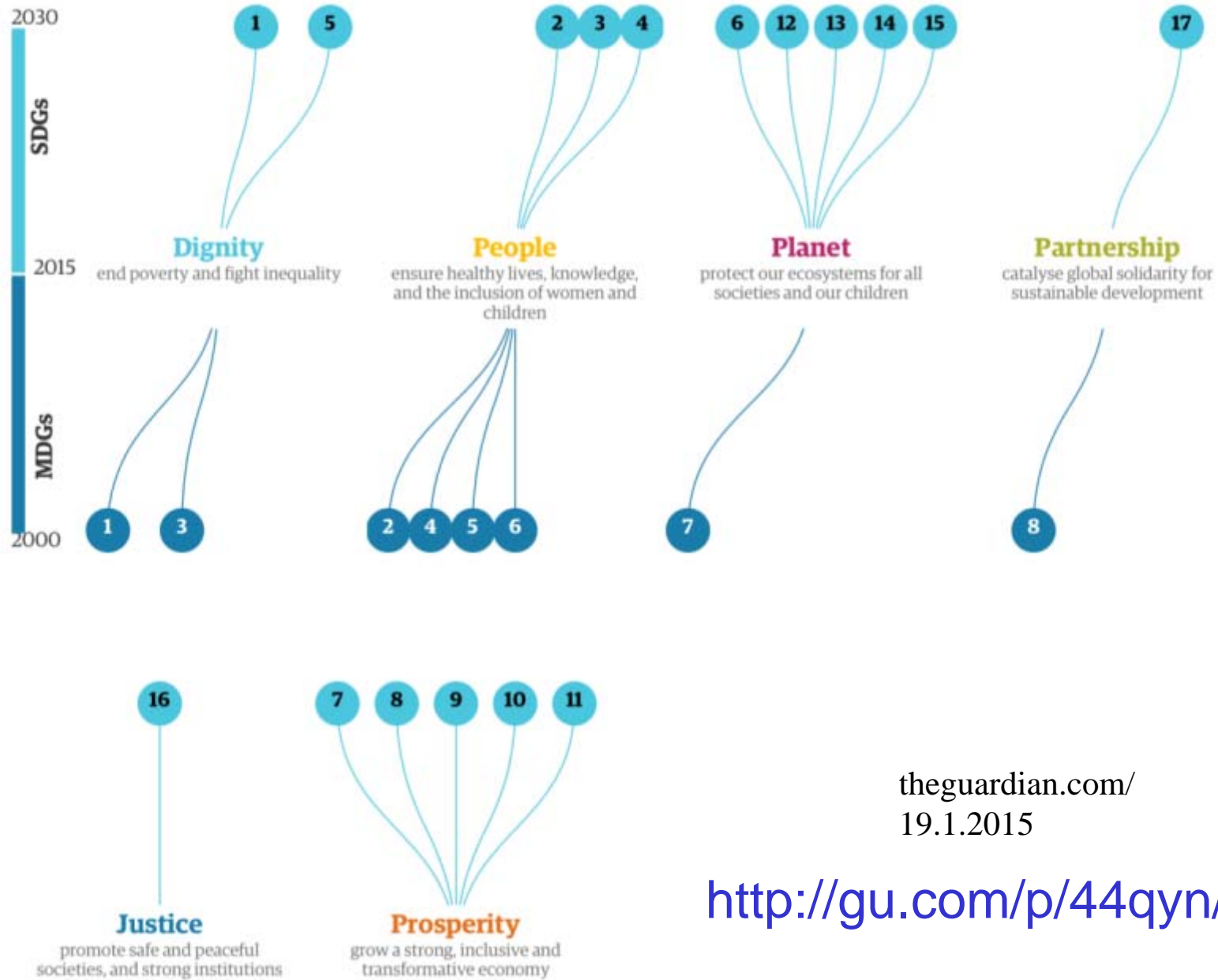

- 
- Ten principles
1. Limited in number and globally harmonized
 2. Simple, single-variable indicators, with straightforward policy implications
 3. Allow for high frequency monitoring
 4. Consensus based, in line with international standards and system-based information
 5. Constructed from well-established data sources
 6. Disaggregated
 7. Universal
 8. Mainly outcome-focused
 9. Science-based and forward-looking
 10. A proxy for broader issues or conditions
