Declaration – 8

We envisage a world of universal respect for **human rights and human dignity**, the rule of law, justice, equality and non-discrimination; of respect for race, ethnicity and cultural diversity; and of equal opportunity permitting the full realization of human potential and contributing to shared prosperity.

A world which invests in its children and in which every child grows up free from violence and exploitation. A world in which every woman and girl enjoys full gender equality and all legal, social and economic barriers to their empowerment have been removed. A just, equitable, tolerant, open and socially inclusive world in which the needs of the most vulnerable are met.

THE GLOBAL GOALS

For Sustainable Development



Target 1.2

By 2030, reduce at least by half the proportion of men, women and **children** of all ages living in poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions



Target 2.2

By 2030, **end all forms of malnutrition**, including achieving, by 2025, the internationally agreed targets on **stunting and wasting in children under 5 years of age**, and address the nutritional needs of adolescent girls, pregnant and lactating women and older persons

3 GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING



Target 3.2

By 2030, **end preventable deaths of newborns and children under 5 years of age**, with all countries aiming to reduce **neonatal mortality** to at least as low as 12 per 1,000 live births and **under-5 mortality** to at least as low as 25 per 1,000 live births

4 QUALITY EDUCATION



Goal 4

Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote **lifelong learning opportunities** for all

Target 8.7

Take immediate and effective measures to eradicate forced labour, end modern slavery and human trafficking and secure the prohibition and elimination of the worst forms of **child labour**, including recruitment and use of **child soldiers**, and by 2025 **end child labour in all its forms**

Target 16.2

End abuse, exploitation, trafficking and all forms of violence against and torture of **children**

Target 17.18

By 2020, enhance capacity-building support to developing countries, including for least developed countries and small island developing States, to increase significantly the availability of high-quality, timely and reliable **data disaggregated by** income, gender, **age**, race, ethnicity, migratory status, disability, geographic location and other characteristics relevant in national contexts



2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development – *Implementation & Financing*

Implementation & Financing Framework

➤ Addis Abeba Action Agenda (July 2015)

- Domestic Resource Mobilisation
- Official Development Aid → LDCs
- Role of private sector and private flows, remittances, illicit financial flows, trade, tax cooperation, sovereign debt, etc.
- Children acknowledged as a population group for special consideration, to protect and to be invested in





Addis Ababa Action Agenda: 7

We recognize that **investing in children and youth** is critical to achieving inclusive, equitable and sustainable development for present and future generations, and we recognize the need to support countries that face particular challenges to make the requisite investments in this area. We reaffirm the vital importance of **promoting and protecting the rights of all children, and ensuring that no child is left behind.**
