- ❑ His efforts reflect the evolution of care coordination which has enabled systems to become high performing delivery models.
- ❑ With support from The Commonwealth Fund, his team developed a framework and potential measures for comprehensive, multi-disciplinary care coordination.
- ❑ The framework is being used to influence the creation of system-wide care coordination in multiple states.

# RICHARD ANTONELLI M.D.

- ❑ He has presented his measures and framework in collaboration with the WHO.
- ❑ He has been an invited presenter at the World Bank and for the International Foundation for Integrated Care.
- ❑ He has served two terms as the Child Health Subject Matter Expert on the Measures Application Partnership Coordinating Committee at the US National Quality Forum (NQF).
- ❑ Co-Chair of the NQF MAP Medicaid Child Workgroup.
- ❑ He currently has collaborative projects with teams in Chile, Canada, and Australia.
